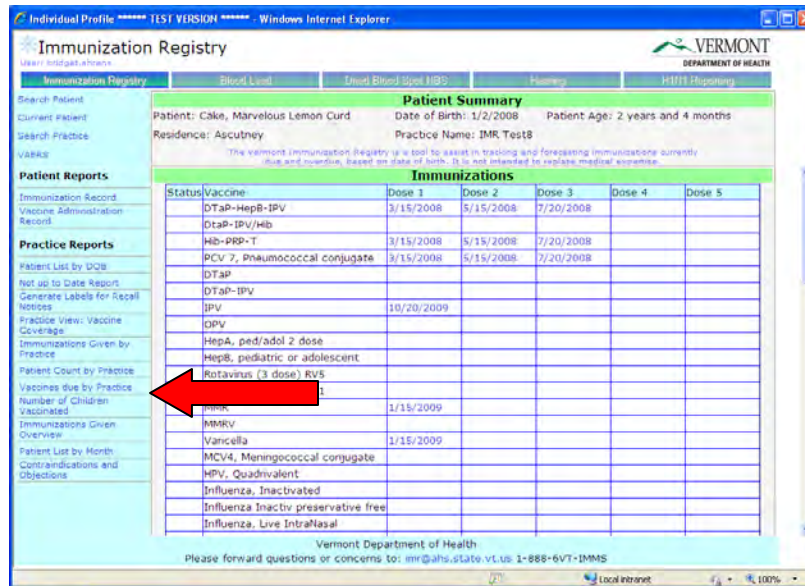


Hot Tip:
The immunization most often responsible for low vaccine coverage rates in Vermont is the 4th dose of DTaP!

How to Use the Vaccines Due Report

What it does: prints a list of children in your practice who are NOT UP TO DATE for immunizations. It includes a list of the specific immunizations each child is missing.

Where it is: to find it, go into any patient record, and go to the Immunization display by pressing Immunization Registry at the upper left corner of the screen. The red arrow below shows the Vaccines Due report.



Background to remember: this report is based on the schedule issued by the Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices.

How to use it: choose the report, enter an age range, and press Create Report.

We recommend running the report for:

- 19-35 month olds (this is the age group practices are measured by for various assessments of vaccine coverage including the National Immunization Survey.)
- 4-6 years olds (especially useful for pre-school assessment.)

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Limitations:

- If you gave an immunization but did not enter/submit it to us, it may not be in the system. (We get *some* information from health insurers, and from WIC clinics.)
- Report is limited to patients under age 18.
- Running the report for all patients under age 18 may generate a very large list, and your connection could “time out.” We recommend using a limited age range.
- Varicella will appear as “due” for patients who have had varicella disease.
